The above figures measure the progress a pupil makes throughout years 3 and 4 (when they are in their Lower School) and 5 and 6 when they are at Henlow Academy.

Every pupil's progress between year 2 and 6 is calculated and combine into one figure that is attributed to the school they attend in May of year 6. The national amount of progress is calculated by the DFE – the figure of 0 means that a child makes average progress.
