To the Parents of Year 4 Pupils transferring to Henlow Church of England Academy in September 2020

Dear Parents / Carers

I am delighted to extend to you a warm welcome to Henlow Church of England Academy and enclose details here of the transition process for every Year 4 pupil joining us in September 2020. It has long been our practice to arrange for every Year 4 pupil to visit the school at least twice in the Summer Term, prior to their transfer the following September. During these unprecedented and extremely unusual circumstances we find ourselves in, we are having to review the way we welcome you and your child to our school.

The first of our usual visits is for our Working Together session, where Year 4 pupils spend almost a complete day at Henlow Church of England Academy, working in lessons alongside our current pupils and generally experiencing the routines and practices of a normal middle school day.

The second visit is a full day "Step Up Day", which is due to take place on Friday 5th July. During this visit, pupils would spend the day in their new class with their Year 5 class teachers, ensuring that they are fully prepared for the big step to middle school in September. Classes will be balanced in terms of gender and ability and will reflect the liaison that has taken place with lower school staff. Pupils would normally meet their new form tutor on Step up Day.

At present, we do not know when years 4 and 5 will return and therefore we are unable to plan for these events. Senior members of our staff also visit each lower school during the summer term to meet every pupil. We are hopeful that we will be able to continue this. As soon as we have any updates from the Government we will be in touch to ensure that your child's transition to Henlow is as smooth as possible,
