**SPORTS RELIEF** - During Sport Relief week we will be running a Beat Beethoven's 5th Symphony challenge in the sports hall. Teams of 4-5 children from the same year group will complete a relay to try and run 5km (50 laps of the sports hall) before the piece of music finishes (30 minutes).
