INFORMATION/REMINDERS

ALL YEARS - **World Book Day** - On Thursday 10th March pupils are encouraged to dress up as a book character to celebrate World Book Day. Each year group has a theme.

Year 5 Magic (This could be any characters that link to books about magic, e.g. Harry Potter, the Worst Witch, The Chronicles of Narnia)

Year 6 Historical Characters (This could link with their history topic of Vikings, or characters from Horrible History books, Greek mythology etc)

Year 7 Everybody's Different (Students could take inspiration from a character in a book or somebody throughout history who has dared to be different, or has something unique that sets them apart, such as Huckleberry Finn, Fantastic Mr Fox, Jo March Nancy Drew or even the Mouse from the Gruffalo)

Year 8 War Literature (A soldier from WW1 or WW2, a Land Girl, a character from a novel set during war times. Note-please make sure any costume is respectful)

Year 9 Sherlock Holmes and Victorian Literature (Year 9 are moving on to study Sherlock Holmes so could they be inspired by the famous detective, or the novels of other Victorian writers, such as Charles Dickens, the Bronte sisters, Robert Louis Stevenson, etc.)

ALL YEARS - Henlow Park by The Pavilion. Henlow Parish Council have asked us to remind parents that dogs are not allowed in Henlow Park. They have received complaints that parents are waiting in the park to collect pupils from Henlow Academy and bringing dogs with them. Please observe the signage around the park detailing the rules.

KEY STAGE 3 - Careers day - On Friday 11th March, Year 7, 8 and 9 will be participating in a Careers Day. The day will include a range of activities to help the pupils think about what they might want to do when they are older and think about how they can start working now for future success.
