You could look at climate change and how we can adapt our behaviours to protect the environment, or your favourite science experiment and how it shows change. This is an opportunity for you to try out whatever home Science project interests you, bonus points if it relates to the theme of change and adapt!


You will present your project at our Science Fair where it will be judged and prizes and certificates awarded.


If you are working towards a CREST award or the Olympiad you can present your project and get some feedback before your final presentation.


