I am really excited to let you know that the bees have now arrived, they have been

successfully moved into their new hives and they are very happy. Ms Cave and I found both colonies to be very calm and a pleasure to deal with.

Beekeeping is an ancient and wonderful craft and without doubt brings huge benefits to those, young and old who keep these fascinating insects.
